

Earn Continuing Development Units (CDUs) for IIBA® recertification. BA workshops and track sessions may count for CDUs. You will need to keep track of your sessions and then review the Recertification Handbooks on the IIBA website to see if they qualify for CDUs. In general, One hour of Professional Development equals 1 CDU for recertification. If you are not already IIBA certified (i.e. a CBAP® and/or CCBA™ recipient) then you can earn Professional Development hours (PD hours) for initial certification. These may be earned from BA workshops but not from 1 hour long track sessions. Please check the certification Handbooks on the IIBA website to see if the workshops you attended qualify for PD hours.

You must also download the Event Guide from this show and keep with your records. The Event Guide will identify the description and key learning points of each session. You are responsible for identifying if your session is valid for CDUs or PD hrs as mentioned above.
